

Hot List Documentation

The data for the Hot List is generated from various tables in the PCC Rddb.

The purpose of the Hot List report is to show the user specific alerts that would have been visible on the PCC system without having to log into PCC and click through multiple pages.

The Hot List is not a replacement for PCC alerts and should not be used as a replacement for PCC alerts. However, it offers a summary of alerts that one would find by logging into PCC and checking all the alert pages.

Some of the alerts shown on PCC are filtered out of the Hot List report. Which alerts are shown are the outcome of discussions between the CHS Care development team and the Clinical Leadership at CHS. The documentation below explains which alerts we use and how we obtain them from the PCC Rddb.

The Hot List is refreshed hourly using the latest information we have from the Rddb. Any delays or issues with the Rddb backup/restore process for the PCC database will result in outdated information on the Hot List.

Since the PCC Rddb is only restored hourly, it is possible to find alerts on PCC that have not yet migrated to the report or alerts on the report that have been checked, cleared, or resolved on PCC that are still displayed on the report.

The time period selector limits the alerts as follows:

- 24 Hrs: Includes alerts with an effective date of 24 hours or less
- 48 Hrs: Includes alerts with an effective date that is greater than 24 hours and less than or equal to 48 hours.
- 72 Hrs: Includes alerts with an effective date that is greater than 48 hours and less than or equal to 72 hours.

e-Interact

- Includes
 - eInteract alert
 - eINTERACT Change In Condition
- The effective date of the alert must have been within the past 24, 48, or 72 hours as selected by the user.

Clinical Alerts:

- Includes only Clinical Alerts for:
 - No Bowel Movements
 - Ate Less
- Excludes:
 - Deleted alerts
- The effective date of the alert must have been within the past 24, 48, or 72 hours as selected by the user.

Priority Progress Notes:

- Includes the text of all progress notes with a type of:
 - 'Incident Note'
 - 'Infection Note'
 - 'Behavior Note'
 - 'Alert Charting Note'
- Excludes
 - Skin/Wound notes
 - 'Weight Change Note'
- Must not have a field strike set to Y
- Must not be deleted
- The effective date of the alert must have been within the past 24, 48, or 72 hours as selected by the user.

Antibiotic and Psychotropic Medications :

- Includes orders for
 - Antibiotics

- GPI Groups: 1-9 (except 6 [reserved])
- Psychotropic Medications
 - GPI Groups:
 - 57: Antianxiety Agents
 - 58: Antidepressants
 - 59: Antipsychotics
 - 60: Hypnotics
- For antibiotics: Orders will show as long as they are active.
- For Psychotropics: Order date must have been within the past 7 days.

Weights and Vitals:

- Includes Weights and Vitals Exception Alerts for:
 - Weight Loss
 - Weight Gain for residents with a diagnosis of CHF
 - Respiration
 - High Temperature
 - Pulse
 - Low O2 saturation
 - Pain Level
- Excludes:
 - BP - Systolic
 - BP - Diastolic
 - Low Temperature
 - High O2 saturation
 - Blood Sugar
- Checked needs to be blank.
- The effective date of the alert must have been within the past 24, 48, or 72 hours as selected by the user.

Sendouts:

- Includes Alerts for:
 - Residents who had one or more “sendout” to an Inpatient Hospital or ED Setting from the SNF in the past 60 days.
- Excludes:
 - Residents readmitted to the facility from an Inpatient Hospital or ED Setting from the SNF, even if this took place in the past 60 days.
- The effective date of the most recent discharge must have been within the last 60 days. This alert will show on each of the 3 lookback periods in a uniform manner.

Admissions:

- Includes Alerts for:
 - Residents who have been admitted to the facility within the past 7 days
 - New admissions
 - Readmissions with an absence from the facility of more than 24 hours
- Excludes:
 - Residents readmitted to the facility after an absence of less than 24 hours.
- The effective date of the most recent readmission must have been within the last 7 days.
This alert will show on each of the 3 lookback periods in a uniform manner.

X-Rays and Labs :

- Includes orders for
 - X-Rays
 - Orders including phrases such as:
 - X-ray
 - XRS
 - CXR
 - KUB
 - LXR
 - TXR
 - AXR
 - One Time Only Labs
 - Labs that are ordered only one time:
 - The order includes the phrase “STAT”
 - The order has a “One Time Only” schedule
- For X-Rays: exclude any orders that are not a direct order for an X-Ray
- For Labs: exclude any orders that are recurring that were erroneously ordered as “One Time Only”
- The effective date of the order must have been within the past 24, 48, or 72 hours as selected by the user.
